<p><b>Request to Vote-By-Mail</b>            A vote-by-mail request may be made in person, by mail, by email, by phone, or online via the website VoteIndianRiver.gov</p> <p><b>Thursday, October 24, 2024 5:00 p.m.</b> is the last day to request a vote-by-mail ballot to be mailed for the General Election.</p> <p><b>Voted ballots must be received</b> by the Supervisor of Elections office no later than 7:00 p.m. on Election Day in order to be counted.</p> <p><b>Secure ballot intake stations</b>, formerly known as drop boxes, are available at all early voting locations during voting hours to return your vote-by-mail ballot.</p>	<p><b>October 21 – November 2            8:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.</b></p> <p><b>Supervisor of Elections Office</b>            4375 43<sup>rd</sup> Avenue, Vero Beach</p> <p><b>Sebastian City Hall Council Chambers</b>            1225 Main Street, Sebastian</p> <p><b>Indian River County Main Library</b>            1600 21<sup>st</sup> Street, Vero Beach</p> <p><b>Early Voting Wait Times</b>            View early voting wait times and locations at VoteIndianRiver.gov.</p>	<p><b>November 5, 2024            Polls Are Open            7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.</b></p> <p><b>Where Do I Vote?</b>            On Election Day you must vote at your assigned polling place. Locate your polling place online at VoteIndianRiver.gov or call 772-226-4700. It is a felony to vote in a precinct in which you do not reside.</p> <p>Address changes within the state of Florida may be processed at any time, including Election Day at the polls. Voters who wait to update their address on Election Day may have a slight delay in voting and may also be directed to another polling place based on the voter's new residence address.</p>

**YOU MUST BE REGISTERED TO VOTE AND YOU WILL BE ASKED TO PROVIDE A PHOTO & SIGNATURE ID.**  
 If you do not have a photo and signature ID, you may vote a provisional ballot, but the process will take longer.

**Need to Update Your Voter's Signature?** 

**WHERE:** Florida Voter Registration Application forms are available at all government offices, public assistance offices, libraries and upon request by calling or e-mailing the Elections Office or visiting the website. **HOW:** Use a Florida Voter Registration Application form completing all required blocks per instructions. **WHEN:** At any point there is a significant change in your signature or identifying "mark".

**Election Day results will be posted on our website VoteIndianRiver.gov and can be viewed on cable channel 13 in Vero Beach, cable channel 27 in Indian River County and cable channel 22 or U-verse channel 99 in Sebastian.**
