Comprehensive Update of the Charter of the Town of Orchid

The Town's Charter was last replaced in 1988 to address the changing nature of the community at that time. The community has evolved a great deal more since then. Updating the Charter is proposed to better reflect the Town now, to clarify and reorganize existing provisions, streamline processes, incorporate new best practices, and align the Charter with current state law.
